



**SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT  
For Northeast Utilities Service Company  
Retiree Health Plan**

This is a summary of the annual report for Northeast Utilities Service Company Retiree Health Plan, EIN 06-0810627, Plan No. 521, for period January 01, 2010 through December 31, 2010. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

**Basic Financial Statement**

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$237,230,460 as of December 31, 2010, compared to \$205,225,900 as of January 1, 2010. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$32,004,560. This increase included unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$82,903,237 including (but not limited to) employer contributions of \$37,544,767, participant contributions of \$14,159,633, realized gains of \$4,530,819 from the sale of assets and earnings from investments of \$26,100,689.

Plan expenses were \$50,898,677. These expenses included \$810,651 in administrative expenses and \$50,088,026 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.

Box 270, Hartford, CT 06141-0270) and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
